BACHELOR'S IN HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

Champlain College Online (CCO) is working with Corporate College Services (CCS) to offer a pathway to a bachelor's degree in human resource management through a combination of CCS courses, and Champlain College Online courses taken at a reduced, preferred tuition. The course map is on the reverse of this page, showing the courses* in the Champlain College Online degree program, and the courses you can take through CCS toward that degree.

Champlain College Online allows up to 90 transfer credits toward a bachelor's degree. Those credits may be earned through a regionally accredited college or university, through credit by exam (AP, IB and CLEP) and ACE and NCCRS approved credits. To transfer, courses must align with the program/course competencies and a grade of "C" or better must have been earned.

Throughout the world, over 500 programs in approximately 425 educational institutions have been acknowledged by SHRM as being in alignment with its suggested guides and templates. The HR Curriculum Guidebook and Templates were developed by SHRM to define the minimum HR content areas that should be studied by HR students at the undergraduate and graduate levels. The guidelines—created in 2006 and revalidated in 2010, 2013 and 2017—are part of SHRM's Academic Initiative to define HR education standards taught in university business schools and help universities develop degree programs that follow these standards.
